As an introduction to the seminar the whole group visited Röcken, the place of birth of Nietzsche, where he lived the first four years of his life, then Naumburg the town where he often stayed later with his mother.

The magnificent cathedral of Naumburg formed the background of 'the Naumburg Variations', a 20 minute performance by Geert Vermeire and Stefaan van Biesen in which several participants took part. The first day ended with a visit to Schulpforta near Naumburg, the old abbey school where Friedrich Nietzsche took lessons.
